The Rachel Carson Center is offering up to three stipends for current members of its doctoral program with an interest in urban environments to join its intensive field seminar in Abu Dhabi. The workshop-style seminar will bring together faculty and students from LMU Munich and New York University as well as artists and professionals for a field-based examination of Abu Dhabi's urban environment. Doctoral students should be prepared to produce a photo essay, create a blog post or think piece, or write an Arcadia article. High priority will be given to students who are planning to do research on the RCC research theme "City Environments around the Globe" in the nearer future.

This workshop is part of a new strategic partnership between New York University and LMU Munich which aims to promote cutting-edge research and transatlantic collaboration. It will be continued through a series of workshops in Munich and New York respectively.

The Abu Dhabi workshop will be led by Sophia Kalantzakos, Affiliated Professor at the RCC and Director of the eARTthhumanities Center at New York University Abu Dhabi. The project's co-leaders are Anne Rademacher, Director of NYU's Urban Greening Lab, and RCC Director Christof Mauch.
